Response:

Higher education objective is to promote team sprit to foster, Innovation, leadership, continuous personality and overall development of students. The Institution Organizes education, cultural and extracurricular activities through various department like NCC, NSS, Red Ribbin club and Child Protection club to fulfill the responsibility.

NSS

National Service Scheme (NSS) Plan was initiated by Government of India to inculcate feeling of social responsibility, social awareness, discipline and dignity of labor among the students pursuing their higher studies. NSS works Under the state organization administration management. At the beginning of session the advisory committees decide about the activities to be undertaken during the session.

In the Institute there are 2 Units women unit and men unit and they both work together with responsibility for fulfillment of duties. It was in 1990 that a men's unit of 50 was introduced for boy students that was increased to 100 volunteers unit in 1996. During 2011 a women unit of 50 students was started that was increased to a unit of 100 students. Now we run two NSS units of 100 members each.

Prof. English, Dr. Bindu Mahawar Prof. Economic organize regular activities along with Blood-donation awareness, Cultural and Literary Programs, Shramdan, Tree Plantation and making the campus polythene and Gutka free. And Nasha Mukti Abiyan, Swachh Bharat, Financial Education, Women Literacy, Save girl child, Child Protection program, Aids awareness program, Gender issue, Covid awareness program by presenting posters, Rally, Street plays (Nukkad Natak) Group songs, group dances, Rangoli & Mahandi etc.

The volunteers are made aware of their responsibilities, vision and mission of NSS. The volunteer are apprised of the activities in details and their expected contribution in these activities. NSS volunteers should be very dedicated, disciplined and always should ready to work for society and institution. They are also required to be environment conscious and are expected to spread this message in college campus and society also. They are also expected to be responsible and conscious Indian citizen..

Extension activities are organized by the institution to let students connect with under privileged sections of society. The students learn to identify with villages by holding special camps in villages. The students learn their social obligations by working in close proximity with people. They make them aware about hygiene and good habits also.

Seven day comp: The NSS units of college work for institution and neighborhood community network.
